<p><u>Committee Charge/Purpose:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● By definition, the SAC is an advisory body to the Board of Directors (BOD) and the final authority on any policy change or adoption rests with the Board. ● Make recommendations to the Parker Performing Arts School BOD and school administration on areas of school culture, parent and student satisfaction, and review the goals established in the Unified Improvement Plan. ● Evaluate progress and review procedures to ensure successful completion of the committees chosen project. 	<p><u>Expected Workload and Timeline:</u></p> <p>Meetings are held four times a year on the first Thursday of October, December, February and April. Meetings will last approximately one hour.</p>
<p><u>Areas of Responsibility:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Recommend goals for the improvement of education in the school using the school developed Unified Improvement Plan as a framework. ● Recommend a plan to improve the educational achievement in the school, focusing on methods of increasing the rating of the school's accreditation category. ● Develop, distribute and summarize school satisfaction survey data collected from parents, teachers and/or students on an annual basis. ● Report to the BOD at a minimum of twice a year on recommendations the committee has summarized through their work. . ● Adhere to the state statute expectations for SAC as it relates to charter schools. 	<p><u>Examples of Responsibilities Not Included:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Final approval of policies. ● Personnel issues, including hiring or evaluation of staff. ● Individual student discipline issues. ● Any issue dealing with a specific student, staff member, or parent.

<p>Members (# and description):</p> <p>Board Liaison - Chair - School Leader SAC will consist of five (5) to seven (7) members, designated or appointed. The SAC members will vote officers in annually. School Principal or designee Two (2) teachers--one(1) representing Academic teaching staff and one (1) representing Artistic teaching staff Parent and community members cannot be employed by or related to anyone employed by Parker Performing Arts School. As defined in State Statute, "related" means a person's spouse, son, daughter, sister, or brother; "employee" means anyone receiving pay from Parer Performing Arts, where taxes are deducted from their pay.</p>	
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
